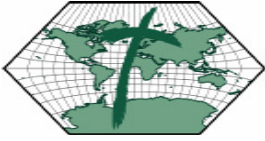

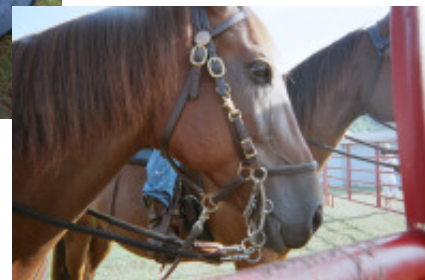
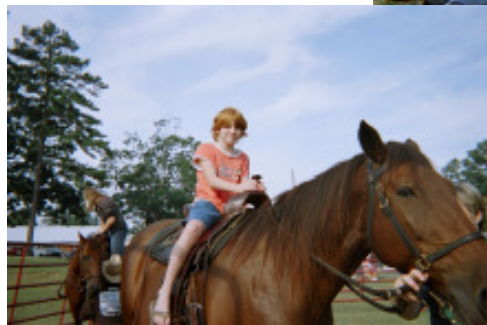

Disturbing Statistics

- **500 pastors leave the ministry each month.**
- **50% of pastors' marriages will end in divorce.**
- **80% of pastors feel unqualified and discouraged in their role as pastors.**
- **70% of pastors constantly fight depression.**

I often hear pastors saying the following: "I am out of emotional energy and I don't think I can handle any more."

How should I pray for my pastor? Well, the next time you feel lonely, fearful or anxious, feel down on yourself and you just want to give up, pray for yourself then pray the same for your pastor.

When should I pray for my pastor? Pray daily in your quiet time, during the noon hour or after the evening meal. Skip a favorite TV program. Get up 30 minutes early in the morning or spend time before bedtime.

Pray for the pastor and family: Pray for their protection, provision and encouragement.
