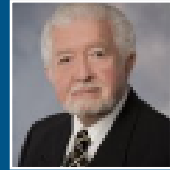

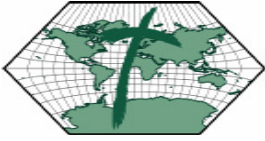
### *The **FACT** of the matter is . . .*

- *The Royal Home Ministries, licensed in 1992, has served 277 young ladies to date.*
- *NewLife Christian Adoptions, licensed in 1999, has placed 69 babies with adoptive parents.*
- *Clients have been served from North Carolina, South Carolina, Pennsylvania, Texas, and Virginia.*
- *A total of 276 babies (including three sets of twins) have been born.*
- *Clients range from twelve years old to the mid-twenties, averaging around 18.*
- *The home is licensed to serve six clients at a time.*
- *About 20% of the clients make an adoption plan.*
- *Beyond the clients served at the home, the staff will counsel by phone hundreds of young women each year.*
- *According to the Alan Guttmacher Institute, The United States is aborting 3,904 pre-born babies a day. That is 162 per hour or 3 per minute. The annual total is 1,425,000 babies per year.*
- *No one is turned away because of their lack of funds. ATAM, Inc. is responsible for raising its own budget.*

## BISHOP CARPENTER CALLS FOR CHURCH-WIDE FAST

Bishop Ronald W. Carpenter, Sr., General Superintendent of the International Pentecostal Holiness Church, is calling for a church-wide voluntary fast for 21 days beginning January 1, 2010. This fast is being called in conjunction with the Awakening America Alliance, of which the IPHC is a part. This is a coalition of many denominations and Christian Ministries who are praying in agreement for a fresh spiritual awakening in our nation. The fast is based on the Daniel Fast of Daniel 1, 9 and 10. Daniel fasted all 'pleasant foods' fasting only vegetables for 21 days. There are many ways to participate: you could fast for 21 days using the Daniel Fast guidelines, fast one meal a day, fast every day after 3 p.m., fast completely for 1 day a week or fast just one certain food or activity. It is completely up to the individual to determine how he or she can participate.

Journaling is a tool that helps you log your journey through the fast and gives expression to thoughts, impressions and insights you would otherwise forget. It is a personal account for your purposes only, but it provides a rich record of your experiences with the Lord each day. In days to come you will enjoy looking back to reflect upon the prayers you wrote and rejoice in the answers to prayer you will encounter.
