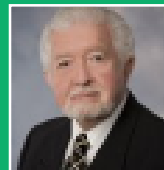

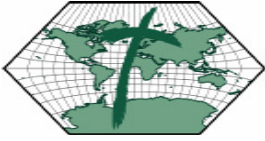

WHAT TO DO WHEN WE CAN'T PRAY!

"Cast your cares on the Lord and he will sustain you; he will never let the righteous fall."

Psalm 55:22

"Sometimes it's not that we don't want to pray – it's that we cannot pray. What then? Here are some suggestions for breaking through when we find it difficult to pray.

- Keep trying. Don't give up- that's just what the enemy wants! Say the words, even if the feelings aren't there.
- Sing hymns that express the way you feel – or want to feel.
- Rest on promises. Use your Bible concordance to discover promises that will help you in your present circumstances. Personalize them by inserting your name.
- Cry to God. Are your prayers choked by tears? Sometimes weeping is praying. Paul says the Spirit intercedes for us when we cannot pray – with groans that words cannot express (Romans 8:26).

Share your burden. Sometimes the burden is just too heavy for one person. Go to a trusted friend and say, "I can't pray. Will you pray for me?"
